Our Environment

Hughesdale Kindergarten has a warm, friendly and welcoming environment that is enjoyed by all. Our indoor space provides the perfect environment for a range of creative and educational activities. Our outdoor environment is well used each session and inspires the imagination and offers opportunity for learning and adventure.

Our kindergarten features:

- Indoor classroom and large outdoor playground
- Piano and dedicated space for music lessons
- Two cubby houses complete with mud kitchen
- Dry riverbed
- Chicken coop with 2 pet hens
- Tricycles and other active play equipment
- Lots of shaded areas provided by trees and 3 shadesails
- Vegetable and herb garden beds and a worm farm
- Play area with climbing equipment, swings and slide
- Gross motor play activity area to encourage climbing and balance

Our Programs

We aim to recognise the importance of these early years and to provide an appropriate environment that is relaxed, warm and nurturing, ensuring each child, family and educator feels a sense of belonging. The early years are a time for a child to take pleasure in the here and now, to spend time playing and experiencing Life's wonders.

Enrolment information

Many of our families are local to the City of Monash Council, and we also welcome kindergarten enrolment applications from neighbouring suburbs and local councils such as Murrumbeena, Carnegie, East Bentleigh, Chadstone

Enrolment applications will be accepted any time after the child has turned 18 months of age. Enrolment applications for both three and four-year-old kindergarten at Hughesdale can be made through the [Monash Central Registration system](#).

When enrolling your child into Kinder, you will be asked to provide three documents to verify your information to Monash Council:

- Proof of address
- Proof of child's date of birth
- Immunisation status

Allocation of kindergarten places

Closing date for enrolment applications for kinder in 2021 is 30 June 2020.

An offer of a kinder place at Hughesdale kinder is provided to families via the Monash Central Registration system in accordance with the eligibility and priority access criteria for our kinder.

Offers commence being made in July/August and continue until the kindergarten is full and/or all children on our wait list have been offered a place.

If your child does not receive a first-round offer for a place at Hughesdale, you may receive a second or subsequent round offer!

Why attend Kindergarten?

Kindergarten is an important step in your child's growth. It is the perfect time for exploration, investigation, and the learning of life skills through trial and error. It is not compulsory, but it is highly recommended that your child attend kindergarten before going to school.

Research suggests kindergarten:

- improves your child's health and wellbeing
- assists them in developing strong social skills
- encourages a love of learning
- enhances children's academic and developmental learning outcomes.
- It can also set your child up for success in the 21st century by teaching them relevant skills

When can your child begin kindergarten?

Three-year-old kinder – your child must be at least three years of age by 30 April in the year which they attend kindergarten. Please note your child cannot commence kinder until they have turned three.

Four-year-old kinder - your child must be at least four years of age on 30 April in the year which they attend kindergarten. Please note your child cannot commence kinder until they have turned four. If your child is born between 1 January and 30 April, they can attend kindergarten when they turn 4 or 5. You need to decide when is best for your child to begin kindergarten. You must make this decision before your child begins kindergarten.

The Victorian Department of Education and Training (DET) has resources to help you decide. You can also seek advice from an early childhood educator at Hughesdale Kinder.

01/05/15 - 30/04/16	2020
01/05/16 - 30/04/17	2021
01/05/17 - 30/04/18	2022
01/06/18 – 30/04/19	2023

There is research to suggest two years of education, based in kindergarten is better than 1. Research from the UK shows that attending two years of preschool improves children's readiness for school more than one year's attendance, with particular impacts on their early literacy and social and emotional skills. And 16 year olds who attended at least two years of preschool were three times more likely to take a higher academic pathway in post-secondary school.

Questions you can ask about Kinders

To help decide if Hughesdale Kindergarten is suitable for you, ask the following questions:

- Does the kindergarten operate throughout the year or only during specific times like school terms?
- Does the service offer a funded kindergarten program with a qualified University Degree Teacher?
- What are the fees and are there any other costs over and above the fees?
- How does the service support children with additional needs?
- What is the process if my child is unwell, upset, or unsettled?
- What is the process for administering medication?

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
